If you have ever wanted to know how to play and win at blackjack, I am convinced that Tracker Blackjack is your number one choice of systems.

Before we get into the system itself you want to make sure that you understand the basics of how to play blackjack. This information is covered in the Tracker Blackjack manual and in bonus manual How to Play Blackjack Like a Pro.

[Place Manual on Table]

Before you can play and win you need to know how to play each hand. Optimal blackjack play is covered by a set of rules known as Basic Strategy.

Because of differences in playing rules between different locales, such as the difference in the way the game is played in northern Nevada and the Las Vegas Strip, and because the number of decks used in a game can affect playing strategy, most experts present a slightly different playing strategy for each variation in rules, with adjustments for multiple decks versus single deck play.

It is far too complicated to memorize pages of different charts, trying to learn slightly different strategies for each rule variation. It is simply not necessary to take this approach to beat blackjack.

Learning every possible difference in how to play your hand will, at best, improve your mathematical probability of winning by 0.03%. If you make a couple of mistakes in playing strategy, because of the complexity of the rules, these will more than negate the slight advantage learning the many variations in playing strategy gives you.

For these reasons, the Tracker Blackjack Playing Strategy uses only one strategy, which can be used in single as well as multiple deck games, with nearly every rule variation.

If you haven't yet done so you should print the Tracker Blackjack Playing Strategy card shown on page 80 of the Tracker Blackjack manual.

[Lay Playing Strategy Card on table.]

You can carry it in your pocket while you are learning basic strategy. This way, you can pull the chart out and study it for a few moments at a time. Most persons learn better by exposing themselves over and over to the same information for short time periods rather than by trying to spend a large amount of time memorizing everything in one session. The pocket card will be a handy reference tool for you.

After you have become very familiar with the playing strategy, you should try writing it down from memory. Another good learning tool is to create a set of index cards. The cards should have the dealer up-card and the player cards on one side and the correct play on the reverse.

Once you have the cards prepared, you can go through them looking at the dealer up-card and player cards and then describe the strategy. Put the cards you answered correctly aside and spend more time reviewing the cards you missed until you are able to give the correct answer for every playing option.

You can also practice with a deck of cards. I learned basic strategy many years ago practicing with cards. Deal one card as the dealer's up-card and two as the player cards. Decide on the correct strategy. If you are not sure, check the strategy card above.

Here is a Quick Review of the Strategy –

1. If the Dealer has an up-card of 7 or higher, you will keep hitting until you have a hard hand of 17 or higher.

Example: Dealer shows 7, we have hand totaling 16. We must hit this hand even though we risk busting.

2. If the Dealer Shows an up-card of 4, 5 or 6 you will stand on a hand of 12 or better. You will only hit if your hand is 11 or lower.

Example: Dealer shows 5, we have hand totaling 12. We stand on hand.

3. If dealer has up-card of 2 or 3, we will stand on a hand of 13 or higher. If our total is 12 we will hit the hand.

4. Hard hand doubling:

11 if a dealer has 10 or less showing
10 if a dealer has 2 to 9 showing
9 if dealer shows 3 to 6.

5. Soft hand Doubling:

Double A,7 and A,6 vs 3 to 6

Double A,5 and A,5 vs 4 to 6

Double A,3 and A,2 vs 5 to 6

These are weaker hands for doubling than the hard hands. On Level-6 and higher bets you may wish to just hit these hands.

6. Splits:

Split pairs of 2s, 3s and 7s, vs a dealer up-card of 3 to 6

Split pairs of 4s vs dealer 5 and 6

Split 6s vs dealer 4 to 6.

Split 9s vs dealer up-cards of 2 to 9 except for when a dealer shows 7.

Always split aces and 8s.

7. Never take insurance

8. If Surrender is offered surrender a hand had totaling 16 vs dealer 10. If 16 consists of 8-8, split instead of surrender.

Your first step in becoming a Tracker Blackjack winner is to learn the Tracker Blackjack playing strategy. With this step along you will play almost even with the house. Once you add the Tracker Blackjack Betting System you will consistently beat the game anywhere it is offered!

Video-2 Tracker Betting

This is Video 2 for Tracker Blackjack. You can follow along in the Tracker Blackjack Video Course.

Video 1 covers the Playing Strategy used for Tracker Blackjack. If you are familiar with Basic Strategy you will see that it is similar to many versions of basic strategy for blackjack. However, with Tracker Blackjack the playing strategy is easier to learn and it eliminates several marginal plays that might be used in other versions of playing strategy.

One huge advantage of using the Tracker Blackjack Playing Strategy is that you will not have to learn different playing strategies for different versions of blackjack. This version works for single-deck to eight deck games and it works for all rule variations.

[Place Playing Strategy Card on Table]

If you haven't printed the Playing Strategy Card you should do so now so that you can refer to it as you play.

In this video we will learn the money bets for Tracker Blackjack. Tracker Bets are the major bets used to beat the game of blackjack. There is also a second set of bets used called Defender Bets that are used as backup bet to Tracker Bets.

The object of using Tracker Bets is to set up winning betting sequences to beat the game.

[Place Bet Layout on Table]

Tracker Bets

(Shown for \$5 Minimum Bets)

Level	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
Bet	5	8	13	20	35	55	90	145	180
After 2 Wins to Level	1	1	1	1	1	1	2	3	5

Here are the rules for using Tracker Bets:

You will always start with the lowest bet shown in Level-1. If you are a \$5 bettor this is a \$5 bet. If you are a \$10 bettor you will use a different betting series where \$10 is the lowest bet. If you are a \$25 bettor then the series for this level of betting will have \$25 as the lowest bet.

[Place Player Cards on Table]

You will find a set of Player Cards in the Tracker Blackjack manual starting on page 192. There is a card for each betting level. Pick up the card for \$5 betting. It shows the same bets we are showing here. You can take the card with you when you play.

With Tracker Blackjack you will carry two cards with you –

The Playing Strategy card that shows you how to play each hand and

The Player Card for your level of play.

Let's cover Tracker Betting for the \$5 betting level.

You will start a game or any sequence after a winning sequence with a Level-1 \$5 bet.

If you win the bet, pick up your win and repeat the same bet for the next round of play.

If you lose the bet you will increase your next bet one level and make an \$8 Level-2 bet.

The general rule is to move up one level following a loss and move down one level following a win.

There is also a Special Rule for winning two bets in a row or two bets out of three.

Let's assume that you are making a Level-4 bet for \$20. You win the bet. For the next round of play you will drop back to Level-3 and bet \$13. If you win this bet too, that you have won two bets in a row and you will drop back to Level-1 for the next round.

Winning two bets in a row will give you a Winning Sequence and will advance your winnings.

There is a other way you can win a sequence and that is by winning two out of three bets.

Assume we win a Level-4 bet of \$20. We drop back to Level-3 and bet \$13. This time we lose. We move back to Level-4 and bet \$20 again. If we win this time we will have won two out of three bets. This is a winning sequence and we will drop back to Level-1 for the next round.

The object of making Tracker Bets is to set up Winning Sequences. Winning Sequences will advance your winnings for the game. The exception is losing a doubled or split bet which will set up back some. On the other hand winning a doubled or split hand will advance you even further.

In general we ignore wins and losses on doubled and split hands in determining our bet level. The exception is when we win a blackjack, a doubled hand or a split hand on a larger bet.

Let's assume that we place a Level-7 bet for \$90, double the hand and win \$180. We may very well decide to drop back to a Level-1 bet or even call the game completed on the next round.

In general, we win a Winning Sequence when we:

1. Win a Level-1 bet or
2. Win two bets in a row or win two out of three bets

Any time you have a winning sequence you can quit at that point and leave a winner (the exception being set backs due to losing doubled or split hands). Most games last about 25 rounds of play. That's the average length of play needed to hit the Target Win for that level of play.

Each level of play has its own Target Win. Take a look at the Player Card for \$5 bets –

[Place Player Card on Table]

For \$5 betting we recommend a Target Win of \$50. If you are a \$10 bettor your Target Win will be for \$100. If you are a \$100 bettor your Target Win will be \$1,000.

The Tracker Bets provide the bets you need to make and win to beat the game of blackjack. However, these bets also act as a Stop Loss for any losing games. If you should ever lose all of the Tracker Bets you will have lost the game. At that point do not continue playing and do not put any more money into to play. Take a break and relax before playing again.

You may have noticed that if you total all of the Tracker Bets that they are greater than the level of bankroll. This was done on purpose. If you lose a higher level bet such as a Level-8 bet and you don't have enough chips to make a Level-9 bet call the game over with a loss.

Even though we are talking about losses it is unlikely that you will experience one. In over 10,000 documented games we never lost. Not even one time!

Video-3 Using Defender Bets

This is Video 3 for Tracker Blackjack. You can follow along in the Tracker Blackjack Video Guide.

Before you start this video you should make sure that you understand how to make Tracker Bets which was described in Video-2.

Tracker Bets are the primary bets for Tracker Blackjack.

[Place poster of Tracker Bets on table]

In the previous video I talked about the betting rules for Tracker Bets. You learned about how to set up Winning sequences and the “Win two in a row” and “Win two out of three rules” used to determine bet sizes.

However, I left a critical factor out –

To prevent losses there are times that you will stop making Tracker Bets.

During these times you will use a different betting series called Defender Bets.

[Place poster of Defender Bets on Table]

Defender Bets are used to prevent losses which occur because of long losing streaks.

Using Defender Bets is triggered whenever you lose two Tracker Bets in a row.

At this point you will change from making Tracker Bets to making Defender Bets.

Here are the Defender Bets for \$5 betting. You can read more about them on page 120 of the manual.

Defender Bets

(Shown for \$5 Minimum Bets)

Level	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Bet	5	5	10	15	25	50	80	120

Defender Bets are not meant to be the main bets used in this system. The main bets are the Tracker Bets. However, whenever we lose two Tracker Bets in a row, we suspend making these bets and start making Defender Bets.

Let's go through this process.

Assume we are a \$5 bettor using these Tracker Bets:

Tracker Bets

(Shown for \$5 Minimum Bets)

Level	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
Bet	5	8	13	20	35	55	90	145	180
After 2 Wins to Level	1	1	1	1	1	1	2	3	5

We make a Level-1 bet of \$5 and lose. We increase our bet one level and make a Level-2 bet of \$8. We lose this bet as well.

Anytime we lose two consecutive Tracker Bets we will temporarily stop making these bets and start making Defender Bets.

Incidentally, both Tracker Bets and Defender Bets are shown on the Player Card for each level of play.

Defender Bets have different betting rules than Tracker Bets.

With Defender Bets you will always start with a Level-1 bet. If you lose it you will move up to the next betting level on the next round of play.

You will continue in this manner until you have one winning Defender Bet.

With any win you will return to Tracker Betting at the Same Level as the last Tracker Bet you lost.

We pick up where we left off.

We have just lost our second Tracker Bet. It was a Level-2 bet of \$8

Defender Bets

(Shown for \$5 Minimum Bets)

Level	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Bet	5	5	10	15	25	50	80	120

Now we start making Defender Bets. We make a Level-1 Defender Bet of \$5 and lose.

With a loss we move up one level and next make a Level-2 bet of \$5. Let's assume we lose this bet as well.

We move up to a Level-3 Defender Bet of \$10. In this round of play we double down our hand and win the bet. The fact that we doubled down and won (or lost) doesn't effect what we do after winning any Defender bet –

We return to Tracker Betting resuming betting at the same level of our last Tracker Bet which was Level-2.

Let's recap what happened here.

We lost a Level-1 Tracker Bet.

We lost a Level-2 Tracker Bet and changed to Defender Betting.

We lost a Level-1 Defender Bet.

We lost a Level-2 Defender Bet.

We won a doubled Level-3 Defender Bet.

We returned to Tracker Betting and resumed betting at the same level as our last Tracker Bet.

You may be wondering why we didn't resume Tracker Betting at a level higher than our last losing bet. If we did we would resume Tracker Betting at Level-3.

The reason we don't do this is to keep our level of Tracker Betting as low as possible. You will win enough blackjacks, doubled hands and split hands to add enough "extra winnings" to make this system quite profitable!

If you are having trouble following this I suggest that you review the Sample Games in the Tracker Blackjack manual.

[Place Tracker Blackjack manual on table]

The Sample Games start on page 121 of the manual.

Video-4 Winning with Tracker Blackjack

This is Video-4 for Tracker Blackjack. You can follow along in the Tracker Blackjack Video Guide.

The starting point for success at Tracker Blackjack is to learn the playing strategy.

The playing strategy is discussed on pages 77 to 80 in the manual. If you haven't done so you need to print page 80 with the player card on it and cut it out so that you can carry it with you.

[Place Tracker Blackjack Playing Strategy on the table]

Before you can win with Tracker Blackjack you will need to know how to use the Playing Strategy. I recommend that you practice online making flat bets (such as \$5 bets) until you are sure that you understand how to use the Playing Strategy.

Many times wins on doubled or split hands are a significant part of our winnings and it is critical that you learn the playing strategy. You can carry the card with you and refer to it as needed.

Before you play you need to decide on your betting level and make sure that you have the bankroll needed for that level.

[Place Player Cards on table]

You can take a Player Card with you which has the information of bankroll, your target win and both Tracker and Defender Bets for each level of play.

For example, if you decide to start out as a \$1 bettor, just refer to the card for \$1 betting. It shows that you need a bankroll of \$100 and that your Target Win is \$10. It also gives all of the bets needed for this level of play.

The best way to learn this system is through practice. I suggest that you practice online in free practice mode and that you record all of your bets using the form used in the Automatic Bet Controller.

[Place Tracking Form on table]

You can see an example of a recorded game on page 23 or the Automatic Bet Controller Manual.

Start out playing in Free Practice mode. We recommend playing at Bovada.lv Be sure to record your games and keep them in a notebook for review. This is the same procedure we recommend for games played for money.

If you intend to continue playing online you can make as many copies of the Tracker Form as you need and use them when you play.

If you are plan on playing in land-based games, you should learn our chip tracking technique described in the Automatic Bet Controller Manual.

You need to master the betting system used by Tracker Blackjack. Our primary bets are Tracker Bets –

[Place poster of Tracker Bets on table]

We always start a game making a Level-1 Tracker Bet. I am showing the bets for \$5 betting. You will pick the Tracker Bets for your level of play. In the manual we show the bets used for every level of play from \$1 to \$500 base bets.

With Tracker Bets we increase our bets one level following a loss and drop them one level following a win.

If we win two bets in a row or two out of three bets we drop our bets to the level indicated in the betting series. For wins of Levels 1 to 6 bets we drop back to a Level-1 bet. For Levels 7, 8 and 9 bets we drop back to the bet level shown here.

Anytime we lose two Tracker Bets in a row we revert to making Defender Bets.

[Place poster of Defender Bets on table]

We Defender Bets we start at Level-1 and increase our bets one level following a loss. We continue to make Defender Bets until we have one win.

With any winning Defender bet we resume making Tracker Bets at the last level we played.

Each level of play has its own bankroll. For example, the bankroll for \$5 bets is \$500. For \$1 bets its \$100.

Each level of play has its own Target Win. We recommend cutting off a game after hitting the Target Win.

Our Loss Limit is our Game Bankroll. If we lose our Game Bankroll or don't have enough bankroll to make a required bet the game is over with a loss.

Fortunately, in real world testing we have never lost our bankroll. Not even one time!

[Place Automatic Bet Controller on table]

You should use the forms in the Automatic Bet Controller to record your practice games.

If you play online I suggest you use the Tracking form for every game.

If you play in land-based casinos you will want to learn to use the Chip Tracking Method explained in the Bet Controller Manual.

[Place Tracker Blackjack Manual on Table]

Before you try to play using this system you should review the Sample Games shown in the manual.

For example you can review Sample Game 1, which starts on page 121. This game takes you through a real game one round at a time. You will find explanations for how to use

Tracker Blackjack's betting system as well as real world examples of blackjack rounds including blackjacks, doubling and splits.

Once you are sure that you have the system down you should try playing in free practice mode in our recommended [Number One online casino](#). You will find details about this casino in the bonus book.

We have taught Tracker Blackjack to many players. It is being used right now in both land-based and online casinos!
